

Instructions for Schools/Applicants

1. We only accept American Legion Auxiliary Tenth District Scholarship forms.
2. It is the responsibility of the applicant to mail their application to the person listed on the application. Make sure applications reach that person by March 1. Mail early!
3. Use blue or black ink. Complete the forms neatly.
4. Each application should contain 4 parts: the application form, transcript, letter of recommendation from a professionally licensed school educator, essay about your veteran.
5. Do not use binders, presentation folders, etc for your application. Just the required pages clipped or stapled together.
