The program consists of pre apprenticeship, apprenticeship, and upgrade training for journeyworkers. By maintaining ongoing education, we are crafting a better bricklayer who not only has the skills to create a superior product but who can move on to better opportunities. We are vested in the apprentices that we create because overtime these apprentices will be the ones who are vesting in us.

## Pre Apprenticeship

Pre Apprenticeship includes 320 hours of basic training. You will learn basic elements in the use of the tools and fundamentals of brick and block laying. This training prepares you for the job site and apprenticeship classes. You will be provided with tools and gear for the job and training. Classes run eight weeks in the spring at the same location as the apprenticeship classes. As soon as you complete your pre apprenticeship, you join the union and start your career.

## Apprenticeship

The apprenticeship is a four year program in which you will gain the knowledge and skill of the Masonry Trade. You will be learning on the job along with classroom and shop time. You will start off 50% of what a journey worker makes along with receiving benefits (Medical Insurance and Pensions). The more you learn the more money you will earn. You will also receive an associate's degree through Ivy Tech Community College.

The apprentice classes are held once a week for eighteen weeks starting in November and completing in March. Each class is an eight hour day and will consist of classroom and shop time. Classes are held in winter months so your summer months aren't disrupted for better opportunities for work.
