Judy M. James Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to provide the individual with financial assistance to pursue education beyond the high school diploma. A \$1,000 scholarship may be awarded. The scholarship will be awarded in two segments. A check for \$500 will be awarded for the first semester and if the recipient's grade point average is 2.00 or higher, a second check for \$500 will be awarded for the second semester.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- Graduating high school senior the year the scholarship is awarded.
- Member of Bar-Cons FCU for at least one year prior to the scholarship application deadline.
- Have average or above average academic performance.
- Have definite plans to attend advanced schooling the first year after graduation.
- Participate in an interview with the selection committee (if deemed necessary.)
- Attach a copy of high school transcripts.
- Submit a double spaced type written page explaining the following:
 - 1] Goals/Career interest
 - 2] Family income, number of children and special demands made on the family income.
 - 3] What school have you chosen to attend and why?

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applications must be submitted to Bar-Cons FCU no later than March 31st. Those postmarked after that date will not receive consideration. Applications are available at the Bar-Cons FCU receptionist desk after February 1, 2019.

NOTIFICATION OF SCHOLARSHIP WINNER

The scholarship recipient will be notified by phone or letter. The recipient's high school will also be notified so that he or she may be recognized at the high school's honor day.

Bar-Cons Federal Credit Union is pleased to announce that a scholarship program for graduating high school seniors will be offered again this year. The Judy M. James Scholarship is a \$1,000 and non-renewable. The applicant must have become a member of Bar-Cons FCU prior to March 31, 2018

The credit union is accepting applications February 1st through March 31st from graduating high school seniors planning to pursue an education beyond their high school diploma. The scholarship winner will be determined by an appointed committee and will be announced at the April credit union board meeting.

It is the hope of the Board of Directors of Bar-Cons FCU that the winners will be awarded a certificate and scholarship during their high school honor day program.

Enclosed is a copy of the eligibility requirements to be handed out to students. Any student wishing to apply for this scholarship will need to complete an application, which will be available at the front desk after February 1st.
