CHAPTER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Criteria for Professional Athletes Foundation Student Scholarship

The PAF Student Scholarship is designed for high school athletes with intentions to attend a 2-year or 4-year college or university. The scholarship rewards high school athletes for their non-athletic achievements and assist them in achieving their academic career goals.

Eligibility

- 1. Overall High School Grade Point Average of 3.2 or better;
- 2. Must be a high school senior;
- 3. Acceptance into a two-year or four-year college or university;
- 4. Nominated by high school coach;
- 5. Participated at the varsity level in athletics for at least one year;
- 6. Has not accepted a full scholarship award or grant (athletic or academic);
- 7. Is **not** the son or daughter of current or former NFL Player.

Criteria for Evaluation

- 1. Career goals;
- 2. Nomination by coach;
- 3. Academic achievement;
- 4. Potential for success;
- 5. Leadership and character;
- 6. Indication of how athletic competition has aided in personal growth.

Nomination Materials

The following materials must be provided to the Scholarship Committee:

- 1. Application completed by student and signed by high school counselor;
- 2. Essay provided by student 500-700 words;
- 3. High school transcript;
- 4. Coach's nomination form and nomination letter.
