The Indiana Council of Teachers of Mathematics will provide grants for up to \$500 each in order to assist ICTM Members in grades K-12 with special classroom projects. Projects may involve one or more teachers and one or more classes. Successful grant recipients will be encouraged to

- present a session about completed project at a fall ICTM conference or
- submit a summary of the project as a manuscript for possible publication in the *Indiana Mathematics Teacher*

To apply, submit a proposal describing

- the objectives of the project,
- a narrative description of the project,
- the project's timeline,
- some way(s) the success of the project will be assessed, and
- a budget for the project.

Limit your response to three typed pages in a standard font, double-spaced with 1-inch margins.
