

APPLYING FOR EDUCATION BEYOND HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

Seniors who plan to further their education after high school need to **apply between now and November 1st**. This is the ideal time in order to meet any admission and/or scholarship deadlines. Students may apply online or by paper. Seniors have been instructed to follow specific procedures when applying.

Applying online: (1) Create a Parchment Account; (2) Fill out the application online; (3) Save the completed application; (4) Print out a copy of the application; (5) Bring a copy of the application to the Counseling Office; (6) Once the application is returned, make any corrections, and submit it; (7) Print out any additional required forms and give to the proper person(s); and (8) Go the Parchment. n e-Transcript be sent.

Once a student's application is submitted online, a student can check the admission status online at anytime. Students need to follow through and check their admission status in order to be sure all material have been submitted and deadlines are being met.

Applying by paper: (1) Neatly fill out the application and (2) Bring the completed application and all required supplemental materials with the application fee to the Counseling Office.

Remember: Procedures need to be followed in order to decrease the possibilities of errors. Use November 1st as a deadline date for applying.
