You have the opportunity to make an education at the University of Dayton, a top-tier Catholic research university, even more affordable for a student from Greensburg Cmty High School.

You can nominate a graduating senior with a passion for personal development and a commitment to service to be a Leadership in Service Scholarship recipient from your school. This scholarship, for students admitted to UD, is worth \$10,000 (\$2,500 per year for four years).
